

## Performance instructions

The metronome markings are for a reference. However, varying should not be more than ten (10) units.

After the first movement it is recommend to have a short pause (silence) at least for a one (1) minute in order to let the ethereal music at the end to raise to its full emotional impact. Although it is not indicated, Finale should follow Scherzo almost *attacca* (without a pause).

Although *Tempo I* (Tempo primo) is meaning "the first tempo" or "the original tempo of a composition or a movement", in the Finale on the measure 76, at the rehearsal letter J, *Tempo I* is referring to the dominating tempo of the movement that is "Agitato", <u>not</u> to the "Andante sostenuto" at the beginning.

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
